- The main market index rose 0.28%, or 16.83 points, to reach 5974.48 at the end of the week.
- The total result of the main market index 50 was green, with a growth of 0.26%, equivalent to 15.08 points, Ending the week trading at a level of 5805.97 points.
- The price of a barrel of Kuwaiti oil rose 81 cents to reach \$82.44 per barrel in trading last Friday, compared

  To \$81.63 in trading the previous day, last Thursday.
- In global markets, Brent crude futures fell by 25 cents to reach \$79.62 per barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate crude futures fell by 2 cents to reach \$75.53.
