

In News

- Kuwait Stock Exchange records a green result for the fourth week and \$394.4 million in market gains.
- The General Market Index closed trading at 7319.32 points, with a weekly increase of 0.28%, gaining 20.48 points.
- The Premier Market Index grew by 0.07% or 5.26 points, concluding the week trading at 7835.97 points.
- The Main Market Index rose by 1.23%, equivalent to 81.55 points, concluding trading at 6703.4 points.
- The Main Market Index 50 stabilized at 6538.16 points.
- The price of a barrel of Kuwaiti oil rose by \$1.27 to \$75.11 per barrel in trading last Friday, compared to \$73.84 in Trading the previous day last Thursday.
- In global markets, Brent crude futures rose by 94 cents to \$75.17 per barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate

 Crude futures rose by \$1.14 to \$71.24.
