

In News

- The main indices of the Kuwait Stock Exchange recorded mixed performance during the week trading.
- The General Market Index increased by 0.08% or 5.73%, ending the week trading at 7186.65 points.
- The First Market Index decreased marginally by 0.04% or 2.88 points, closing the week trading at 7819.16 points.
- The Main Market Index rose by 0.65%, gaining 39.19 points, as it ended trading at 6109.86 points.
- The Main Market 50 Index ended trading at 5866.24 points, declining weekly by 0.65%, equivalent to 38.32 points.
- The price of a barrel of Kuwaiti oil decreased by one cent, reaching \$74.64 per barrel in trading last Friday,

 Compared to \$74.65 the previous day last Thursday.
- In global markets, Brent crude futures fell \$1.63 to \$71.06 a barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate (NYMEX)

 Crude futures fell \$1.48 to \$67.67.
