

In News

- The main indices of the Kuwait Stock Exchange varied for the fifth consecutive week.
- The General Market Index rose by 0.34% or 24.6 points, ending the week trading at 7197.07 points.
- The Premier Market Index concluded the week trading at 7789.84 points, with a marginal decrease of 0.01%, equivalent to 0.5 points.
- The Main Market Index rose by 2.01% or 123.57 points to close the weekly trading at 6271.86 points.
- The Main Market 50 Index jumped by 2.08% to 6126.28 points, gaining 124.97 points during the week.
- The price of a barrel of Kuwaiti oil rose by 34 cents to reach \$73.84 per barrel in trading last Friday

 Compared to \$73.50 in trading the previous day last Thursday.
- In global markets, Brent crude futures rose 38 cents to settle at \$71.89 a barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate crude rose 51 cents to \$68.18 a barrel.
